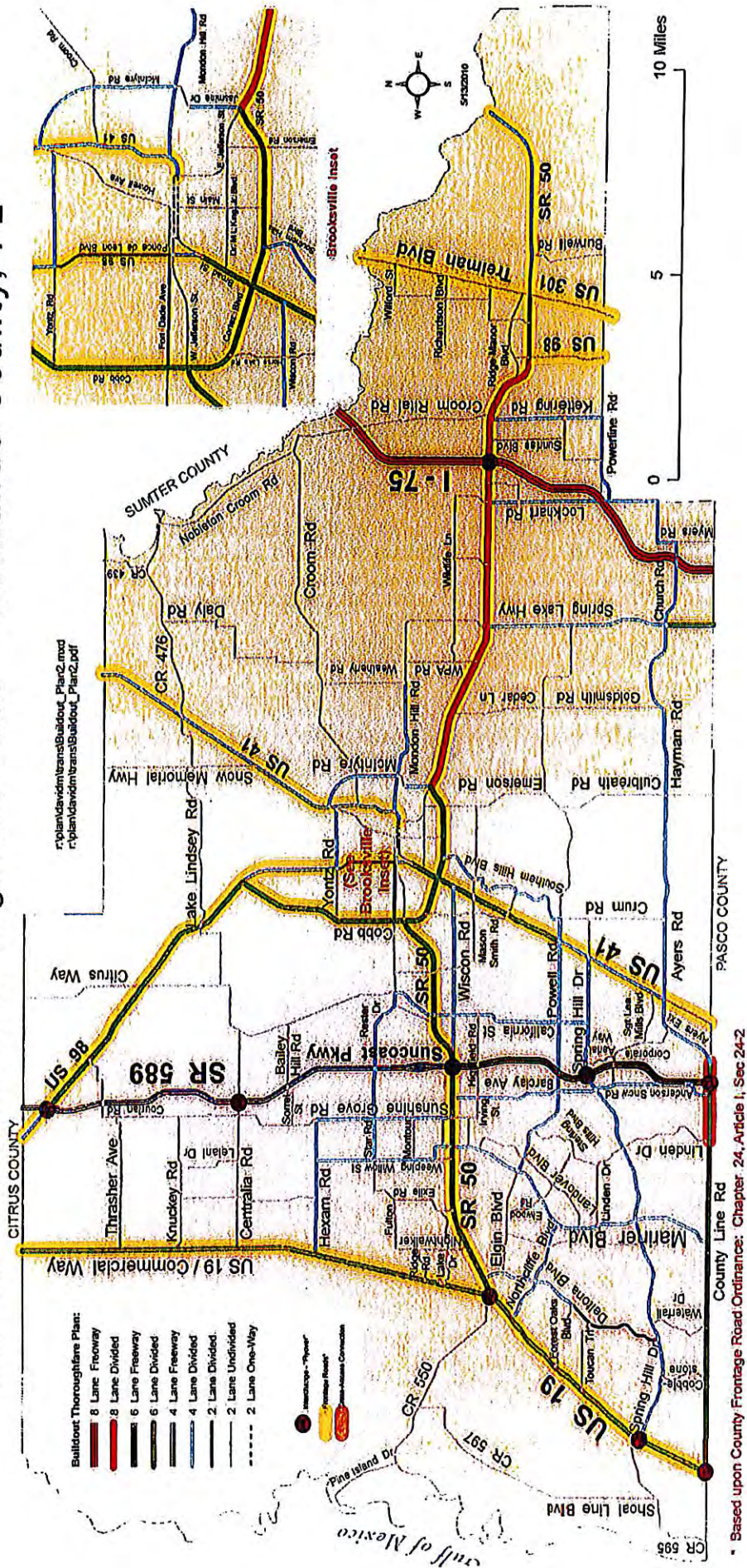


MAP A: Buildout Thoroughfare Plan - Hernando County, FL

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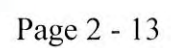
MAP C: Hernando County Bicycle Facilities Map

MAP E: Hernando County Multi-Use Trail Facilities Map



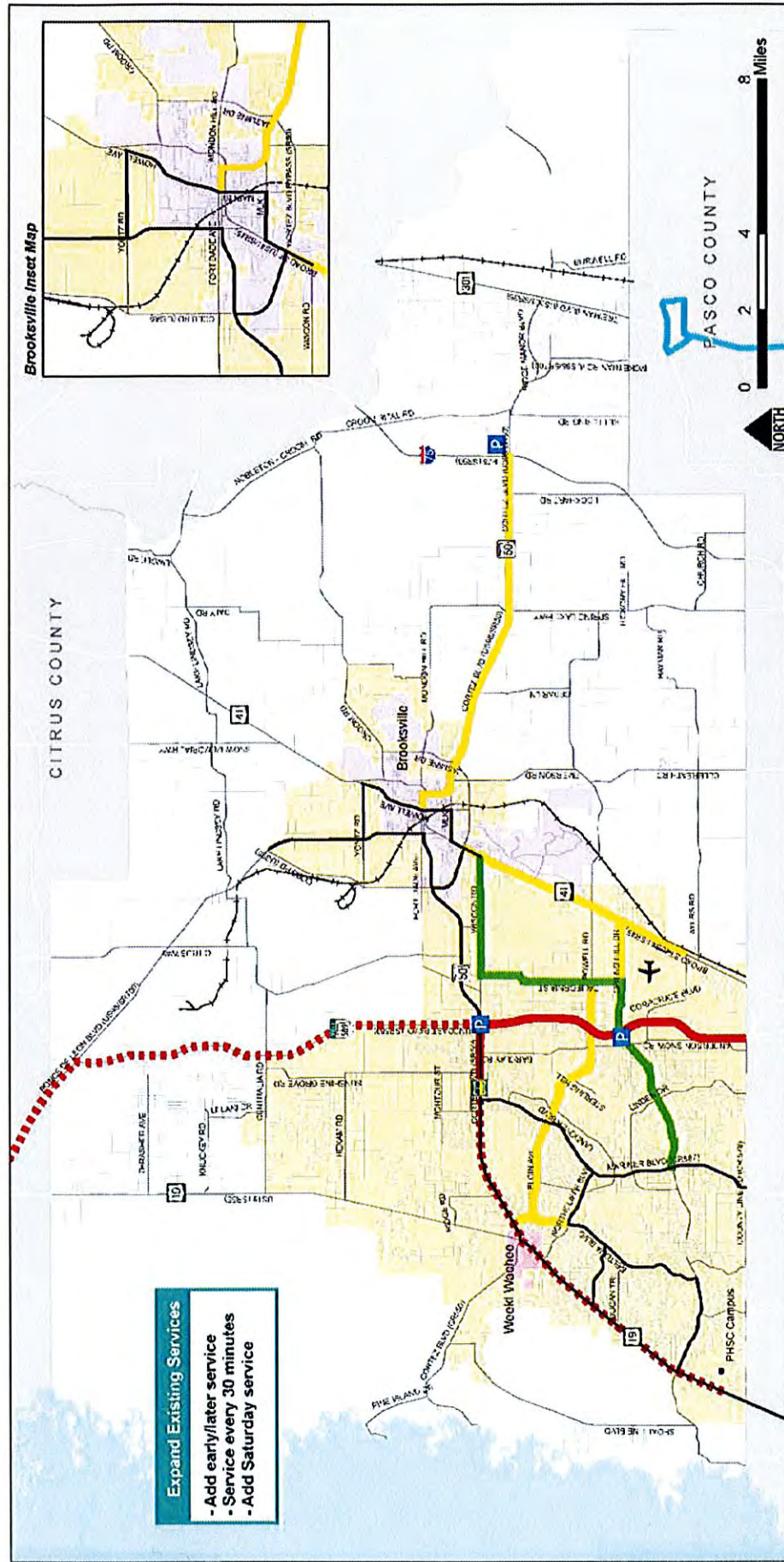
